DIRECTIONS TO YUKON HIGH SCHOOL

From I-40: Take exit 138 (Yukon Parkway / Mustang Rd). Go to end of off ramp and turn north. Go 1 mile and campus will be on your left. Turn into main entrance at the front of YHS and then turn right at the T.

From Kilpatrick Turnpike: Take I-40 West exit. Stay on service road to stoplight. Turn North/Right and go 1 mile. Campus will be on your left. Turn into main entrance at the front of YHS and then turn right at the T.

From Rt 66: Go to the stoplight at Yukon Parkway. Turn south and go 3 miles. Campus will be on your right. After you cross the railroad tracks turn into the main entrance at the front of YHS and then turn right at the T.

MAPS

Please refer to the campus map and the field map included in this handout.

PARKING AND EQUIPMENT LOGISTICS

Turn into the main entrance and go right at the "T." This road will take you around to the side of YHS where our staff will meet your bus and guide you to the location where your floor, equipment and students can be offloaded. After offloading, your bus driver will be directed to the bus parking area. Please park busses and vehicles with trailers in the bus lots only and do not take up room in the spectator lots.

CHECK IN

Check in is labeled on the map. Units will be assigned holding areas in the high school.

FLOOR AND PROP LOADING/UNLOADING

Buses and trailers may pull up to the corner by the prop storage area as noted on the map. An unloading crew will be able to assist you in any way necessary. Your floors and props will be placed in our Auxiliary Gym next to the equipment warm up and performance gym.

SOUND CHECK

Sound checks will take place one hour before the contest begins and during breaks.

WARM UP

You will have guides to assist you in moving to the warm up areas. Please meet your guide at the check in table 5 minutes before your warm up begins. There will be a separate body and equipment warm up. Body warm up will take place in the Pom Room. Equipment warm up will take place in the Cheerleading Room. The route to the performance site is notated on the map.

INSPECTION

There will be equipment inspection as the gym floor has been replaced and special assurances have been given to our administration that all equipment is padded and no damage to the floor will occur. Therefore, please make sure that all equipment is padded as per WGPO guidelines by visiting wgpoklahoma.org

VIDEO

Mr. Video will be taking professional recordings of each unit and selling these DVDs at the contest. Due to the DVD sales, we ask that you do not record this performance. All directors will receive a copy of their unit's performance.

PERFORMANCE SITE

Your guides will lead you on a pre-planned route where you will be led into the performance area. At this time you or your floor crew will take your floor/props to the performance area entrance.

Your Performance: The timeline for this contest will be vertical. Enter: back right, Exit: back left (from audience's perspective). For all other performance guidelines, please consult the WGPO information found at wgpoklahoma.org.

FLOOR FOLDING

After your performance, you will be led to the floor folding area which is located in the Auxiliary Gym as notated on the map. There are no stairs. If you wish, you may leave your floor/props in the prop/floor storage area, or you may load at this time.

GROUP PICTURES

Immediately following folding your floor, your guide will lead you up the stairs to take your professional group picture.

PERCUSSION EQUIPMENT

The band room is available for warm up if needed for weather. If this is the case, a staff member or guide will lead you to this area. A staff person will be available to assist you with any logistical issues that may arise. There will be power available on the performance area floor. All doors leading in and out of the performance area are double doors and will have all bars removed.

CONCESSIONS

Concessions and other amenities will be located in the performance area lobby

BOOTHS

Booths including merchandise, air grams, fan favorite, etc. will be located in the performance area lobby by concessions.

RETREAT

This is a full guard retreat. Units should meet in the floor/prop storage gym immediately following the last scheduled unit of the first and second half of the day.

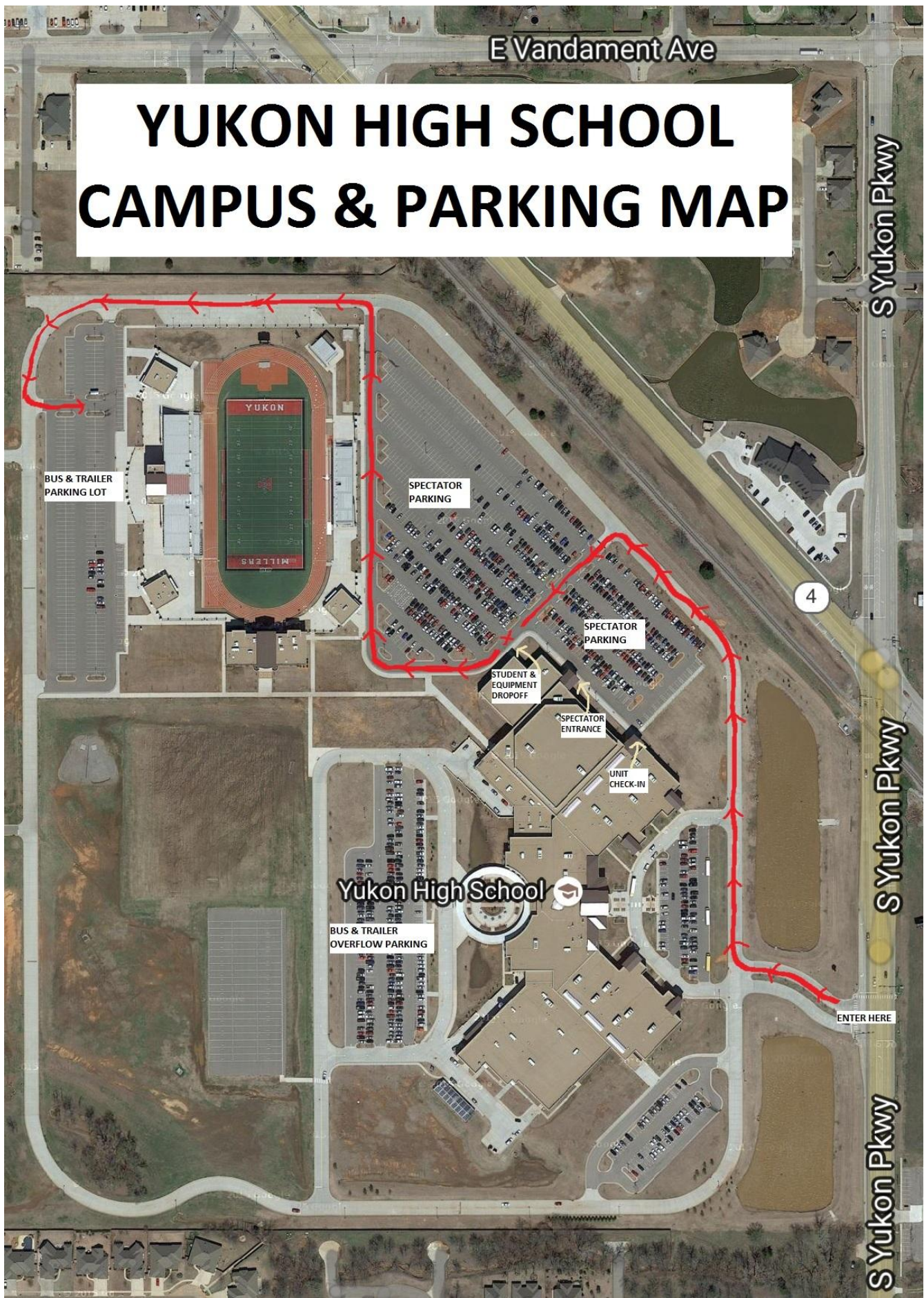
