



Thank you for choosing to attend the WGPO contest at Jenks High School. Our goal is to provide you and your students the opportunity for the best and most rewarding performance conditions possible. Please contact any Jenks personnel should you have any questions not addressed in this packet.

## Contest Flow

- **Unit Check-In**

Unit Check-In is located in Building 2 as indicated on the Campus Map on page 4 of this packet. Individual guard holding areas are located in both Building 1 and Building 2. Units will not be assigned designated holding areas in these buildings, but space is provided on a first come, first serve basis. Once Building 2 nears capacity, the arriving units will be placed in Building 1. Please contact Unit Check-in for assistance.

- **Floor/Prop Unloading & Loading**

Equipment vehicles will be sent to the Performance Venue (Building 6) where they will unload at the double doors on the east side of the building along N. 4<sup>th</sup> St. Once unloaded, they will be instructed to park in Parking Lot 8. See the Performance Venue Map for details on the exact location of the Prop Unloading doors.

- **Inspection**

There will be equipment and prop inspection as the Performance Venue is a fairly new facility and we have given special assurances to the school administration that all equipment will be inspected for proper padding so to not damage the floor.

- **Warm-up Area**

Your guide will escort you as you travel outside to the Warm-Up area (Buildings 3 & 4).

- **Performance Venue**

Your guide will escort as you travel outside from the Warm-up area to the Performance Venue. Your guides will lead you on a pre-planned route. At this time, you or your floor and prop crew should plan to ready and move your props and floor to Unit Entry as indicated on the Performance Venue flow map.

- **Floor Refolding**

Weather permitting, an outdoor floor folding area will be available as your unit exits the Performance Venue. You may return your floor and/or props to the Floor/Prop Unloading & Loading Area after your performance for later pickup.

- **Concessions**

Main concessions along with other vendors will be located on both levels of the Performance Venue lobby area. There will be a separate satellite concessions table with lite snacks located near Unit Check-in.

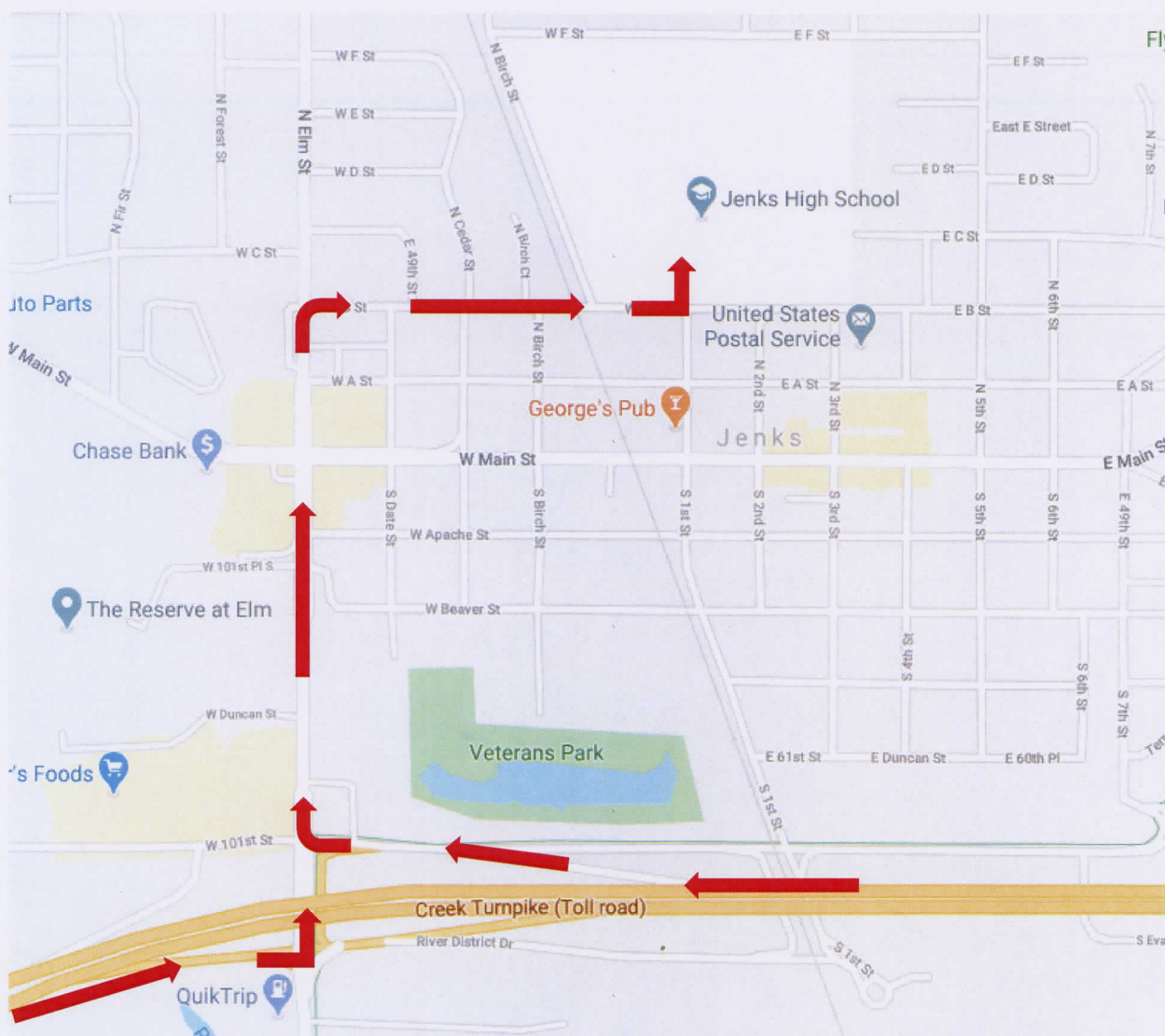
- **Retreat**

Units traveling from the east or west side of the State should take the Creek Turnpike and exit at the "Peoria-Elm Jenks" exit. From there, you will turn north on S. Elm St. After passing through the stoplight at W. Main St., make a right turn at the next stoplight on W. B St. Cross over the railroad tracks and turn north at the stop sign which is N. 1<sup>st</sup> St. There you will be met by one of our traffic coordinators who will direct you to Unit Check-In.



# Bus Parking Directions



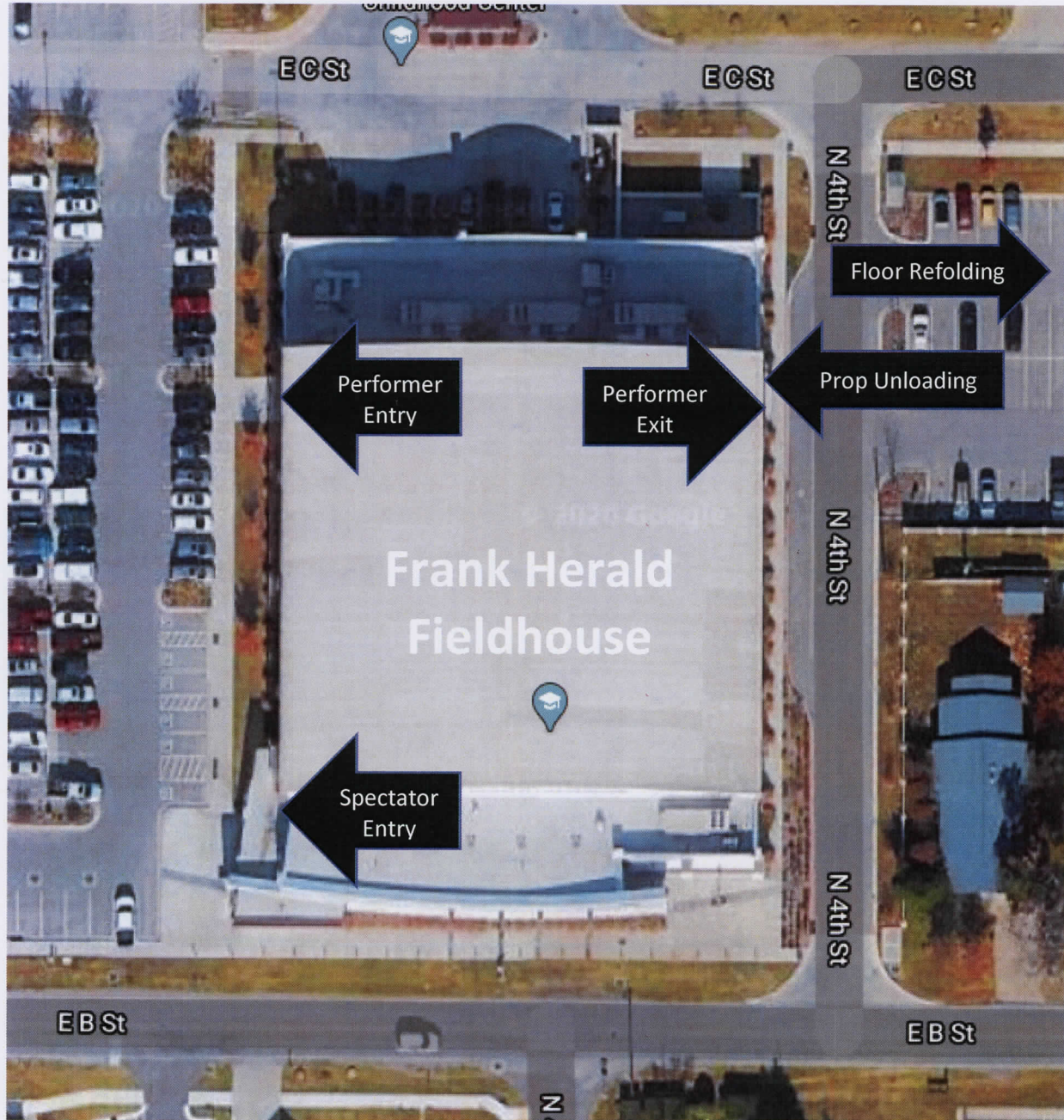
# Campus Map

# Performance Venue





## Jenks High School, Jenks, OK

Per WGI rules, all contest sites must have a minimum of seventy by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and can extend to the maximum of 78' X 106'

The "competition area" at this event measures 75' X 100'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.
