Directions

McAlester High School 1 Buffalo Drive McAlester, Ok, 74501

McAlester High School is located off E. Van Buren Avenue on Buffalo Drive. Spectator entry for the McAlester Activity Center is located at 1717 E. Van Buren Avenue, directly across the parking lot from the high school, within the newly constructed Randy Hughes Middle School. Clear signage will be posted throughout the campus to assist spectators in navigating from the parking areas to the entrance. Doors will open one (1) hour prior to the first performance, and admission is \$10 for adults and children. Children under the age of five will be admitted free of charge.

Unit Check-In

Unit check-in will be located in the cafeteria of the Lucy Smith Center. Upon check-in, you will receive a packet containing a copy of this letter, campus maps, and the event schedule for the day. Additionally, you will receive wristbands for all performing ensemble members along with ten (10) additional wristbands for staff and volunteers, in accordance with WGPO regulations. A trash bag will also be provided for your students to use in their designated holding area throughout the event. We kindly request that all participants utilize the provided trash bags and the receptacles located throughout the facility to help maintain a clean and welcoming campus environment.

Spectator Parking

Spectators will enter the campus from E. Van Buren Avenue and park in the designated lots near the performance gym. All parking areas surrounding the Randy Hughes Middle School and the event center will be available for spectator use. An additional parking lot will be opened as needed to accommodate event attendance across from the Lucy Smith Smith Center, North of the McAlester Activity Center.

Bus Parking

Buses will enter off of E. Van Buren Avenue via Buffalo Drive. Parking will be available in the band practice lot on the west side of the Wanda Bass Fine Arts Building.

Equipment/Box truck Unloading

Box Truck unloading will be on the back side of the McAlester Activity Center. They will enter off of E. Van Buren Ave. **This area is for unloading only**, drivers should follow directions down the road and into the large parking area for the High School, trucks and trailers will be parked on the band practice lot with their buses as space allows.

Unit Camps

Each unit will have a designated holding area in the hallways of the McAlester High School to store small bags and personal items if necessary – keeping personal belongings on your buses is advised. Dressing rooms for participating groups may use the bathrooms at Unit Check-in and in the hallways where unit holding is located. A guide will arrive at your designated time to take you to warm-up.

Please have the members of your organization police themselves in picking up trash in their holding areas. Trash bags have been provided in your welcome packet for your convenience, and there will be receptacles throughout the facility, so please use them during your time with us.

A prep table will be available in the holding areas, including hair ties, mirrors, hair spray, and other miscellaneous items necessary for performance prep. The table will be located in the cafeteria area next to warm-up and unit check-in. Signage will be posted to direct groups to this area.

Prop Storage/Floor and Tarp Storage

Prop and/or tarp storage will be located in the hallway immediately as you enter the Performer/Unit entrance to the performance gym. Volunteers will be on hand to help guide members.

Warm-Up A & B

It will be located in the gym in the Lucy Smith Center. A guide will escort your group from holding to warm-up. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with timing.

Performance Area

There will be a <u>horizontal timeline for this contest</u>. You will enter from side 2 back corner and exit from side 2 front corner (or enter back right, exit front right from audience perspective). Please refer to the gym map for all details regarding entry and exit.

Floor Folding

An outdoor folding area will be roped off just outside the exit ramps for all units. This area will be available at a one-time interval only per unit.

Concession - Souvenirs - First Aid

We will be selling concessions throughout the contest, located in the lobby of the McAlester Activity Center (Performance Gym).

First aid will be available in the McAlester Activity Center and close to the warm up area in the Lucy Smith Center throughout the contest.

Local Restaurants

While we appreciate your patronage of the concession stands throughout the day, we understand that you may need something more substantial to fuel your performers. Handicapped Seating
